

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 62 of the constitution it was moved, seconded and carried at the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 11th February 2008 that a by-law be made to read: -

By-Law No. – Eleven (11).

Service of Alcohol Policy.

This House Policy represents a commitment by the Board of Management of the Somerton Bowling Club to promote the responsible service of alcohol and to provide a safe and enjoyable venue for patrons. This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis and is in keeping with the philosophy of the Licensed Clubs of South Australia Inc. The policy is supported by Good Sports, the Drug and Alcohol Services South Australia and the Government of South Australia.

Responsibilities of the Somerton Bowling Club.

- This Club has a policy to serve patrons in a responsible manner.
- Staff will assist patrons with professional and friendly service.
- Drinking in moderation will be promoted to patrons.
- This club actively discourages combining drinking and driving.
- Staff will not serve/supply liquor to any person under the age of 18 years.
- Staff will not serve any patron to intoxication or continue to serve an intoxicated person.
- The club will encourage patrons to consume low or non alcoholic drinks.
- This club will assist patrons with the arrangement of safe transport options, where appropriate.
- The excessive and rapid consumption of alcohol will be actively discouraged.
- Management may request a person to leave the club if they are a minor, intoxicated, or acting in an offensive and/or disorderly manner.

Service of Alcohol Policy

Responsibilities of the Somerton Bowling Club.

(Cont.)

Minors

- Liquor will not be supplied or sold to persons under the age of 18 years.
- Identification may be required to receive liquor service.
- The only acceptable forms of identification for liquor service will be:
 - Proof of Age Card
 - Current Drivers Licence
 - Passport
- Student Cards are not an acceptable form of identification.

Intoxication

- Staff will not serve any patron to intoxication.
- Intoxicated persons will not receive service.
- Intoxicated persons may be required to leave the licensed club.
