

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 62 of the constitution it was moved, seconded and carried at the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2013 that a by-law be made to read: -

***By-Law No. – Fifteen (15)***

***Disputes and Discussion on Management Issues and Pennant Selection.***

Any dispute between a member and an officer of the Club relative to: -

Policy decisions by the Board of Management.

Pennant selection or declining to play after pennant sides have been selected.

Other issues relative to the administration of the Club.

should be discussed at a suitable time and in an appropriate manner which is not belligerent, abusive or confrontational.

Where possible such matters should be discussed at an arranged meeting with the appointed Director, Chairman of Selectors or other relevant officer of the Club.

The Board has directed that officials of the Club will not be available for discussion of contentious matters on pennant or other bowling competition days. Members are therefore directed **not to make contact** with office-holders on controversial issues on these occasions.

Any member ignoring this directive or refusing to play after teams have been selected, may be reported to the Director of Bowling Activities who shall have the authority to apply a level of sanction which could include: -

Suspension from pennant play for seven days,

Recommending demotion to a lower side of pennant competition.

Suspension from pennant play pending review by the Board of Management.

The Board of Management may subsequently consider appropriate action in accordance with the provisions of Rule 20 of the Constitution -- 'Disciplining of Members'.
