

***By-Law No. – Ten (10).***

***Care of Greens.***

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 24.1.6 of the Constitution (previously Rule 62 of the superseded Constitution) at the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2024 that By-Law 13 be amended to include the hours of use of the greens during the off pennant season. The By-law now reads as under.

It is widely accepted that we have the best bowling surfaces in the State. In order that we maintain this status, the Greens Management Committee has requested that members assist them by exercising care in the following manner whilst using the greens.

1. Place the bowls on the green – i.e. do not drop them onto the playing surface.
2. Wear recognised flat sole bowls shoes.
3. If a walking stick is required, have an authorised rubber base attached.
4. Avoid sitting on the bank of the green. However should it be necessary, ensure that both feet are on the green and **not** in the ditch or on the edge of the green.
5. In order to share the workload on the greens, whenever possible please avoid using the greens immediately outside of the main exit doors.
6. Do **not** commence practice or roll-ups before 10.00am on any day on which the greens are open during the months from and including September to April and from 11.00am from and including May to August except when Tournaments or Bowls S A events are being played.

NOTE: -

Unless otherwise advised the greens are open every day but **closed on Mondays.**

The Greenkeeper and the Greens Management Committee will very much appreciate your cooperation in keeping our greens to such a high standard by addressing the above issues.
