



In accordance with the provisions of 24. 1.6. of the Constitution (previously Rule 62 of the superseded Constitution it was moved, seconded and carried at the Board of Management meeting held on Monday 19th December 2023 that a By-law be made to read:

By-Law No. – Eighteen (18). Rotation Of Players

1 In a situation where Selectors are faced with an excess number of players a decision to rotate a player must be fair and equitable.

2 Rotation should not extend above the fifth side of a Saturday or above the third side of a Wednesday or above the second side of a Thursday.

3 A player may request to be rotated on a particular day which will be at the discretion of the Chairman of Selectors.

4 When it is necessary for rotation to be implemented, before a decision is made consideration shall be given to the premiership ladder of the relevant side to give the side the utmost opportunity of playing in the finals.

5 Consideration should also be given as to whether a particular side is in the promotion or relegation zone nearing the end of season and as to whether an individual player is qualified to play in final matches for a particular side.

6 At all times any decision must adhere to the Conditions of Play of the Metropolitan Bowls Association.

7 The Chairman of selectors will have the final say as to the player/s to be rotated on any given day.

8 Any player who is on rotation in a particular week will be entitled to one free game of Social Bowls during that week or the subsequent week.
