

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 24 1.6.of the Constitution (previously Rule 62 of the superseded Constitution) it was moved, seconded and carried at the Board of Management meeting held on 17 January 2022 that a By-law be made to read: -

By-Law No. – Fifteen (15)

Temporary Closure of the Club & Access Control for Member Safety.

This Bylaw shall only come into effect in the event of natural disaster, emergency, epidemic or pandemic conditions which threaten or have the capacity to threaten the health or safety of members, staff and visitors.

In such conditions, the Board shall have the ability to temporarily:-

1. Close the club;
2. Suspend member access and/or privileges
3. Suspend social bowls and/or night owl competition;
4. Cancel functions due to be held at the club with a full refund of any deposits or fees paid unless the club is unable to recover fees it may have paid to others in relation to the function.

To invoke this Bylaw, the Board of Management shall notify all members of the specific change in operations by giving written notice (via email and text message) at least twenty four (24) hours prior to their effect. If instructions are given to the Board by Government authorities which do not allow at least twenty four (24) hours notice the Board may act immediately.

In particular reference to the health and safety risks associated with the COVID 19 pandemic, the appointed Covid Marshalls are empowered to require the sighting of valid certificates, evidencing the required vaccinations, from any individuals who have entered , or wish to enter, our Club facilities and report to SA Police any individuals who do not comply with such requests.
