

SOMERTON BOWLING CLUB PENNANT ROTATION POLICY

Introduction

From time to time, depending on numbers of available players to fill our Pennant sides, it may become necessary to rotate players in order to spread the load of those not selected to play in that week. This document outlines the Club's policy in relation to Rotation.

Our Club's vision for Pennant Selection

Players are selected in the grade most appropriate for their skill level and club requirements. Where there are more players than required to fill our sides, some players in lower sides may be required to take turns in standing down so that more players have the opportunity to play bowls.

Criteria for Rotation

1. Where required, Rotation shall apply to the bottom 2 sides on Saturday and Wednesday.
2. Players whose participation is restricted to 1 only Pennant Competition (e.g. Wednesday), shall not be selected for rotation on that day.
3. A player selected for rotation for a particular match and subsequently plays on that day (due to last minute vacancy) shall be treated as having been rotated.
4. Players may nominate to be rotated.
5. Selectors shall be the sole arbiters of who is selected for rotation.

A record shall be maintained of players rotated and to the extent possible rotation shall be shared equally.
